# **CONCURRENT SESSION TOPICS**

#### SENIORS' HOUSING FORUM

#### A: Home & Independent Living: Health and Home

This session will focus on seniors' housing options for home living in apartments, condos and houses, and will also discuss home living supports, such as day programming and personal care services.

#### **B: Future Housing Models**

This session will include a panel that explores a variety of innovative housing models that are being considered for and/or under development in Edmonton in the future. The benefits and challenges of these exciting initiatives are considered.

#### **C: Financial Literacy and Housing**

This session provides information on strategies for planning finances to support housing choices. Guidance will also be offered on accessing income supports and other financial benefits.

#### D: Supportive & Facility Living: Health and Home

This session will provide an overview on supportive living, facility living and designated supportive living options to help address the questions and concerns seniors face when choosing the optimal environment in which to live beyond independent living, as well as health supports available to complement these environments.

#### E: Landlord & Tenant and Condo Rights

Knowledge of your rights and obligations as a landlord, tenant and condo owner can greatly impact your enjoyment of your home and your financial security. This session provides an overview of key issues and legislation.

#### F: New Government Initiatives

Municipal, provincial and federal governments are working with communities to address seniors' housing needs. This session explores new policy direction, initiatives and trends as it relates to the role of government in seniors' housing.

#### **G: Community Resources**

This session will give an overview of some practical resources that allow seniors to age in place and receive support in the community. It will describe city-wide services offered by senior-serving organizations that provide resources designed to help seniors live safely and independently.

#### H: Caregiver Support and Family Dynamics

This session outlines supports available to families and caregivers as seniors transition from one housing environment to another. Strategies for handling family dynamics, positive transitions, caring for the caregiver and stress related to moving will be discussed.

#### I: Downsizing/Managing Your Move

This session will provide an overview of things to consider when downsizing and planning your move; resources available to assist with this process, considerations for what to bring to your new home; and practical ways to minimize the challenges and stress associated with this transition.

# **CONCURRENT SESSION TOPICS**

#### **HEALTH & WELLNESS FORUM**

#### 1. My Health

This session will focus on health resources, planning for a healthy future and the role of health professionals in wellbeing.

#### 2. My Home

This session will focus on an overview of seniors' housing options for home living in apartments, condos and houses, as well as supportive living and facility living.

#### 3. My Transportation

This session will review the many city-wide public and private transportation options available to older adults and those with limited mobility. Participants will be provided with the information and resources to help develop a transportation plan to meet individual needs and to help keep them mobile.

#### 4. My Finances

This session provides information on strategies for planning finances to support aging well. Guidance will also be offered on accessing income supports and other financial benefits.

#### **5. My Connections**

Focusing on the importance of social connection to our health and wellbeing, this session will touch on topics such as volunteerism, brain health and preventing social isolation.

#### 6. My Safety

This session highlights the importance of reducing safety risks as we age, and addresses topics such as fall prevention, safe medication use and fire safety.

#### 7. My Supports and Services

This session will give an overview of some practical resources that allow seniors to age-in-place and receive support in the community. It will describe city-wide services offered by senior-serving organizations that provide resources designed to help seniors live safely and independently.

#### 8. My Community

This session highlights the services and programs that support healthy aging, touching on topics such as recreation centres, seniors centres, physical fitness programs and the role of allied health professionals in wellness.

#### 9. My Partner and Me (if applicable)

This session focuses on resources that can support our key relationships as we age, including topics such as caregiver supports, family dynamics and legal documents that you should have.
