- AADL is a cost-share program. Clients pay 25% of the benefit cost up to a maximum of \$500 per family per year. If you receive provincial income assistance, or if your income is below qualifying thresholds, you may be exempt from cost-share payments.
- To obtain AADL funding, you must be assessed by an approved healthcare professional. That person determines what equipment and supplies you can get through the AADL program. If you are eligible, they will give you an authorization for products from AADL's product list.
- To find an approved healthcare professional, you can contact your local health care centre or hospital, or call HealthLink at 811. Let them know what kind of equipment or supplies you are looking for, and ask them to help you find an AADL Authorizer or Specialty Supplier.





- An annual eye exam with your optometrist can help detect serious eye diseases before they compromise your sight.
- Optometrists recommend that babies have their first exam between six and nine months. At least one eye exam between the ages of two and five, and annually for everyone after age six.
- During an eye exam, your optometrist examines the tissues and structures inside the eye, looking for eye diseases.
- Many common eye diseases have no early signs or symptoms.
- Medically necessary and urgent care services are provided by optometrists. They have the proper knowledge, tools and equipment necessary to diagnose, treat and refer to a specialist, if needed. This includes things, such as: eye infections or injuries; foreign objects in the eyes; monitoring diabetes; and postoperative care.
- Check with your optometrists about your Alberta Health coverage for appointments.
