The Seniors Safe House provides temporary housing for older adults who are leaving abusive situations. It is the only program in northern Alberta that offers this support to seniors. During their stay, residents of the Seniors Safe House receive meals and toiletries free of charge to help them on their recovery journey. In addition to monetary donations, donations of new items and supplies help sustain the Safe House, and are **greatly appreciated by residents**.

These items and supplies are needed at the Safe House year-round:
